Director's Thoughts

This year I'm delighted to be returning to direct a new show that has a wonderful story against a great score. I'm really looking forward to working with a team, who are ready to have fun and get into their groove.

It's important to point out that Sister Act the musical has no songs from the film and in fact the recording of the professional show isn't the same as what we will be performing. There are two songs that are different. If you listen to the CD please see it just as a guide to style and for an idea of some of the songs.

Those who have already worked with me will know that I'm looking to tell a story and this is a story with a big heart. Like most modern musicals the book is based on a film rather than an actual book and therefore has the Hollywood factor, meaning our job is to read and look at the subtext. All of the characters in this show have a big part in the story telling and are real characters. I want you to read and look at the story and watch the film which shows you the story. It's not a love story, it's about

humans and people coming together, which is the side of the show that I'm interested in. I want you to see past the glitz and glamor and see the humans and their lives.

As always this is a big show and there is lots to do for all involved. There are many nuns, but lots of other bits for people to do. There are lots of male characters too, so it's not just about nuns!! I've listed the characters below. There are no ages or descriptions listed because I'm keen to see at audition what you interpret the role to be. It's your chance to show us what you think. At the audition, play and explore and be truthful to the song/text you are given!

I'm keen to get a company who are committed and want to have fun at rehearsals but ultimately work hard.

I'm not going to say much more, but will go into a lot more detail on 5th July. I look forward to see you all then.
